


What is the California Evidence-Based Clearinghouse (CEBC)?

The CEBC is a free-to-access website that provides information on over 430 intervention & prevention programs for children, youth, and parents. The CEBC reviews and summarizes the published, peer-reviewed research evidence for each program and uses the evidence to give the program a simple rating, if applicable.



How can CASAs benefit from understanding & using the CEBC?

CASAs help to ensure the needs of children and youth involved in child welfare are met, including referring them to important services such as educational support, therapy, life skills classes, and many other types of services. CASAs can use the CEBC to stay up-to-date on what works for meeting the needs of their case and, when appropriate, inform their recommendations to the court.
