"What is the California Evidence-Based Clearinghouse for Child Welfare (CEBC)?"

The CEBC (www.cebc4cw.org) is a tool that can help Family Resource Centers (FRCs) identify, select, and implement evidence-based practices (EBPs) that can improve child safety, increase permanency, and/or promote family well-being.



"Why should our FRC use an EBP or the CEBC?"

As an FRC, your work with children, youth, and parents plays a significant role in reducing and preventing child abuse and neglect. EBPs can strengthen and enhance your work on meeting the needs of the families you serve. The CEBC can help your FRC:



Understand what makes a program evidence-based



Identify programs that target a variety of issues for children, youth, and adults



Learn how to select and implement EBPs in diverse service settings



Identify screening or assessment tools to measure family well-being
