"What is the California Evidence-Based Clearinghouse for Child Welfare (CEBC)?"

The CEBC (www.cebc4cw.org) is a critical tool for the identification, selection, and implementation of evidence-based practices (EBPs) relevant to the welfare of children and youth.



"Why teach my students about EBPs and the CEBC?"

EBPs need to be taught to students, who will potentially work with families involved in the child welfare system, in order to strengthen their ability to best meet the needs of children, youth, and parents. If you are teaching courses in child development, criminal justice, law, public policy, psychology, and social work, you can use the CEBC to:



Teach your students how to identify programs for children, youth, and adults with various characteristics and needs



Teach your students how to evaluate the research conducted on various child welfare-related programs



Teach your students how to effectively select and implement EBPs in the real-world
