<i>Adult Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI- 2.1)</i>	Examine risk for practicing abusive and neglecting parenting and child rearing behaviors. For use with adolescents 12–19; Adult Parent and Pre-parent Populations.	Self-administered	Arabic, English, Haitian Creole, Spanish	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Alabama Parenting Questionnaire</i>	Measure positive and negative parenting practices. Target population is children 6–18 years.	Parent form: Parents or caregivers; Child form: Self-report	Chinese, Dutch, English, German, Norwegian, Spanish	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Child Abuse Potential Inventory (CAPI)</i>	Screen for the detection of physical child abuse in parents or primary caregivers.	The parent or caregiver	Croatian, English, Greek, Spanish	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Keys to Interactive Parenting Scale (KIPS)</i>	Assess the quality of parenting behavior for families with young children 2–71 months of age.	Family services practitioners; program evaluators and researchers	English, Spanish	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>NCAST Parent-Child Interaction Teaching Scale (PCI-T)</i>	Measure the quality of dyadic interaction, predict cognitive and social-emotional outcomes, and serve as an outcome evaluation tool of parenting quality and parent interventions for parent/caregiver dyads with children birth to 36 months of actual or corrected age.	Public health nurses, home visitors, social workers, early intervention therapists, psychologists, and allied health professionals	Chinese, English, Japanese, Korean	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Parenting Scale</i>	A brief measure of parenting behavior and dysfunctional discipline.	Self-report	English	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)

<i>Parenting Sense of Competence Scale (PSOC)</i>	Measure parenting self-esteem and two aspects of parents' self-reported competence: feelings of satisfaction and efficacy in the parenting role for parents of children 0-17.	Self-report	English	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Parenting Stress Index (PSI)</i>	Measure the relative stress in the parent-child relationship for parents at risk for child abuse and neglect.	Parents	English	A (Psychometrics Well-Demonstrated)
<i>Resource Parent Self-Assessment on Caregiving for Teens (RPSAC-T)</i>	Assess resource parents' knowledge, perceptions, attitudes, and skills to care for teens aged 12-20 placed in their homes.	Resource parents	English	B (Psychometrics Demonstrated)
<i>Skills Assessment for Parents with Intellectual Disability</i>	Assess parenting skills in parents with intellectual disabilities who are living with their children under the age of 18.	A Master's level clinician (in social work or a related field) who is evaluating parenting skills prior to or during the process of working with parents	English	B (Psychometrics Demonstrated)
<i>Treatment Foster Parent Satisfaction Survey (TFP-SS)</i>	Measure treatment parent satisfaction and retention in adults 18 years and older who are providing foster care to youth placed in their home.	Foster parents	English, Spanish	B (Psychometrics Demonstrated)
