

Family Centered Treatment (FCT) Logic Model

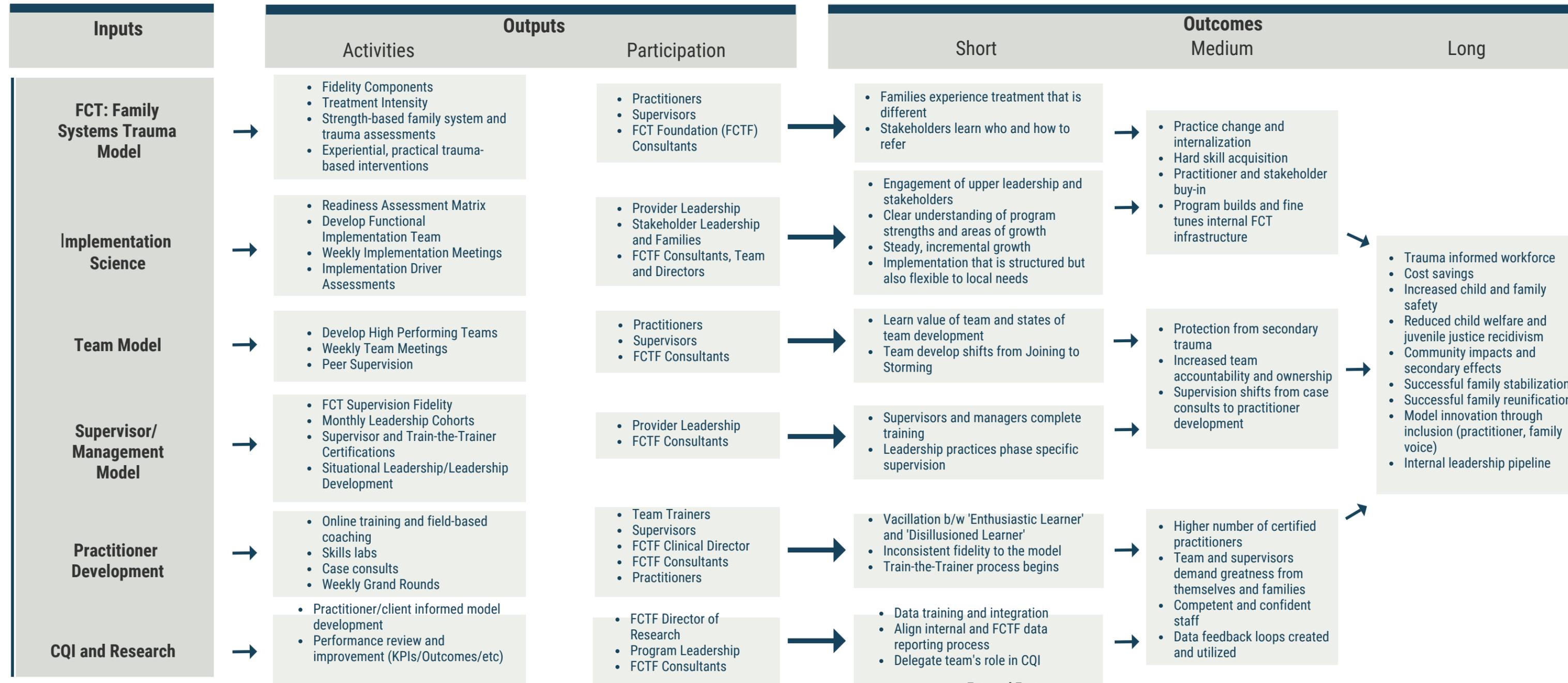


Key Action: Stabilization and reunification for at-risk families

Situation: State, county, and/or providers looking to improve outcomes for at-risk children and families

Priorities: Implement evidence-based treatment models that achieve strong outcomes for a wide variety of target populations and designed for replication.

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- Pillars of Family Centered Treatment**
- Treat families with dignity and respect
 - Honor the function of behavior
 - Treatment that is relevant and useful
 - Internalization over compliance
 - Power of Giving

- External Factors**
- National Child Traumatic Stress Network member
 - Sustainable funding for start-up and ongoing service provision
 - Community involvement
 - Congruence with organizational culture and values; strong, historical stakeholder relationships
 - Community collaboration in stating needs and the rationale for the service
 - Invested stakeholders
