

## Logic Model - MBF Child Safety Matters (Grades K – 5) & MBF Teen Safety Matters (Grades 6 – 12)

Purpose: The National Child Traumatic Stress Network reports that 1 out of 4 children has been or will be exposed to some type of victimization. Child victimization is a complex problem requiring a multi-faceted response. A known, effective part of the solution is prevention education.
