

Logic Model- TRE-ADD Respite Program

Inputs (Resources needed)

- Trained staffing compliment (Behaviour Consultant, Program Supervisor, Manager, Direct support staff)
- Residential Respite home
- Program Materials
- Transportation for families

Activities (Services Provided)

Program Orientation

- Physical tour
- Demonstration of ABA programming
- Plan of care is developed
- Discharge plan is developed

Child Observation

- Behaviour Consultant observes child's interactions with staff and environment
- Develop an individualized behaviour overview based on observations

Respite Visits

- Staff work directly with child to implement ABA programming (incorporating individual preferences, providing choice, and on-going and consistent reinforcement)

Discharge

- Upon completion of 10 days of respite, a discharge report is completed (summarize behaviour data, and preference assessment data)
- Discharge report is mailed to families who can provide to other service providers

Outputs (Products, Participants)

- Parents will receive overnight stays at respite care
- Parents will be provided Respite summaries including preference assessment results, behaviour overviews, and outlined successful strategies
- Children will learn life skills

Outcomes (Benefits)

- Parents will receive a break from caregiving duties, and may improve parent-child relations
- Children will have a safe environment to learn new skills
- Once discharged, parents can utilize documents provided for future community supports to increase community opportunities for the child
