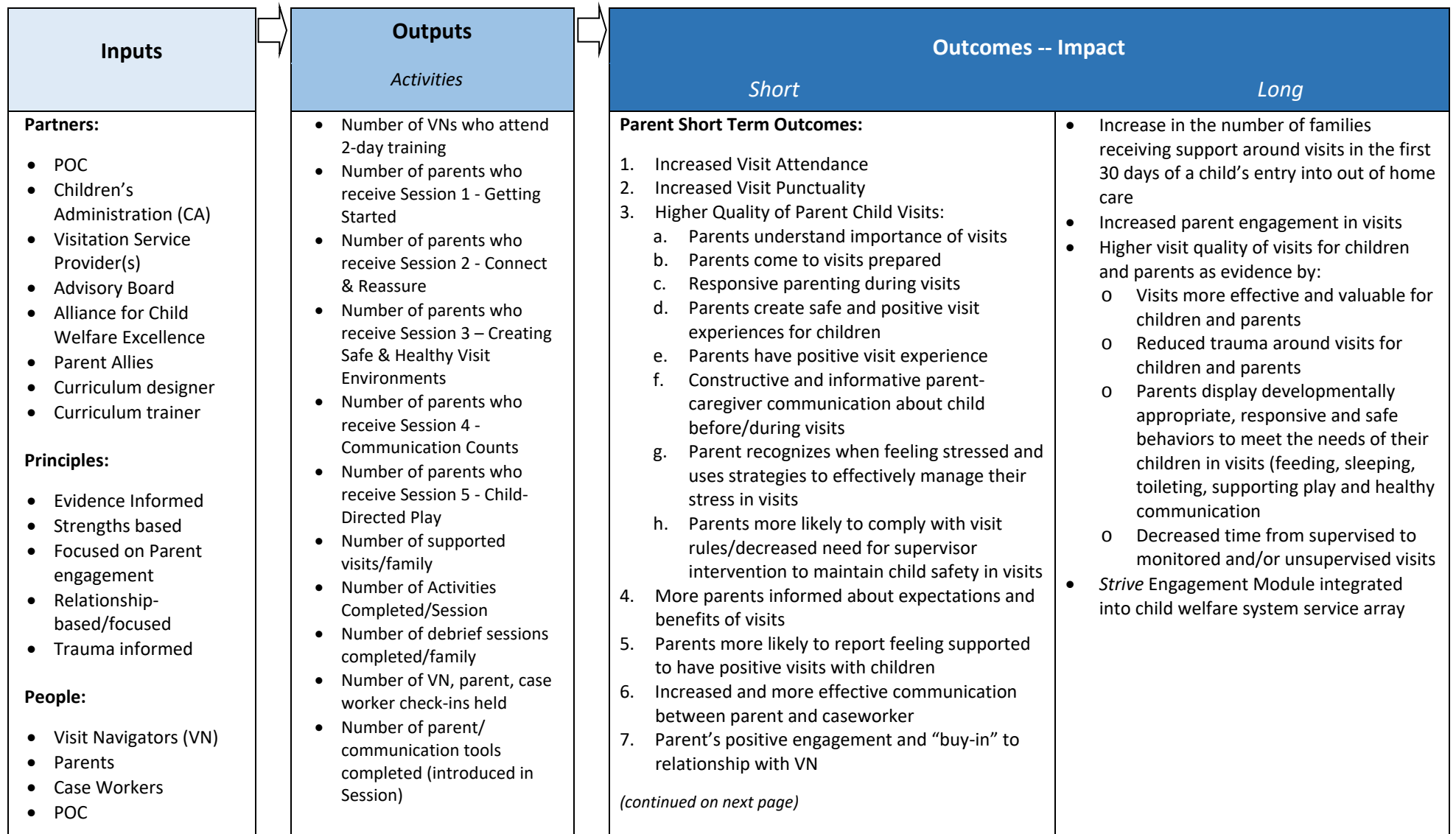


Strive Supervised Family Time Logic Model
